GROUP PROJECT - THREE BICYCLE PLAN PROJECTS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ORDINANCE, FY 2026-27

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro, has received funding from the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) under the federal Surface Transportation Block Grant Program-Direct Attributable (BGDA) for the construction of three projects identified in the 2021 Bicycle Plan Update: (Shelton Street Sidepath, East Poplar Avenue pedestrian lane, and 100 Block Maple Avenue Contraflow); and,

WHEREAS, local funds are required and have been designated in the Town's general fund to match the NCDOT BGDA funding award as part of the FY26 budget;

WHEREAS, the Town Coucil has approved and authorized the Town Manager to execute a Municpal Agreement with NCDOT to administer this federal funding to construct the three projects; and,

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO THAT:

- 1. The Group Project to construct the Three Projects in the 2021 Bicycle Plan (Shelton Street Sidepath, East Poplar Avenue pedestrian lane, and 100 Block Maple Avenue Contraflow); Capital Improvement Project is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.
- 2. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the Town of Carrboro to complete the project:

3. The following amount is appropriated for this project to be expended in the following manner:

Construction \$ 1,112,000.00
