





## Municipal Damages and Losses

#### **Insurance Estimates:**

- Town Vehicles: Up to \$2M reserved for 42 pending claims
- Town Building and Contents: Up to \$572k
  - Includes damages to buildings, furniture, supplies and other property contents
- Town Heavy Equipment: Up to \$328k
- Town Technology Equipment: Up to \$141k
- Continuity expenses: Up to \$50k
- Total: Up to \$3.041M



## Municipal Damages and Losses

#### **Budget Estimates:**

- Budget action to receive and appropriate up to \$3M in insurance proceeds forthcoming in future budget amendment request
- Manager reallocation of \$350k in FY2026 Public Works Budget for continuity of operations during disaster response
