# Briefing:

- ◆ The land that makes the church and the Carolina Car Wash used to be one tract of land that was purchased by Green Cordal and Benjamin Craig so it is fitting that the marker be bestowed on the church side of the street.

Green Cordal & Benjamin Craig, freed from bondage, purchased this land for a Freedman School and church. With funds from the Society of Friends, they built a schoolhouse that served hundreds of free Black children and adults.


