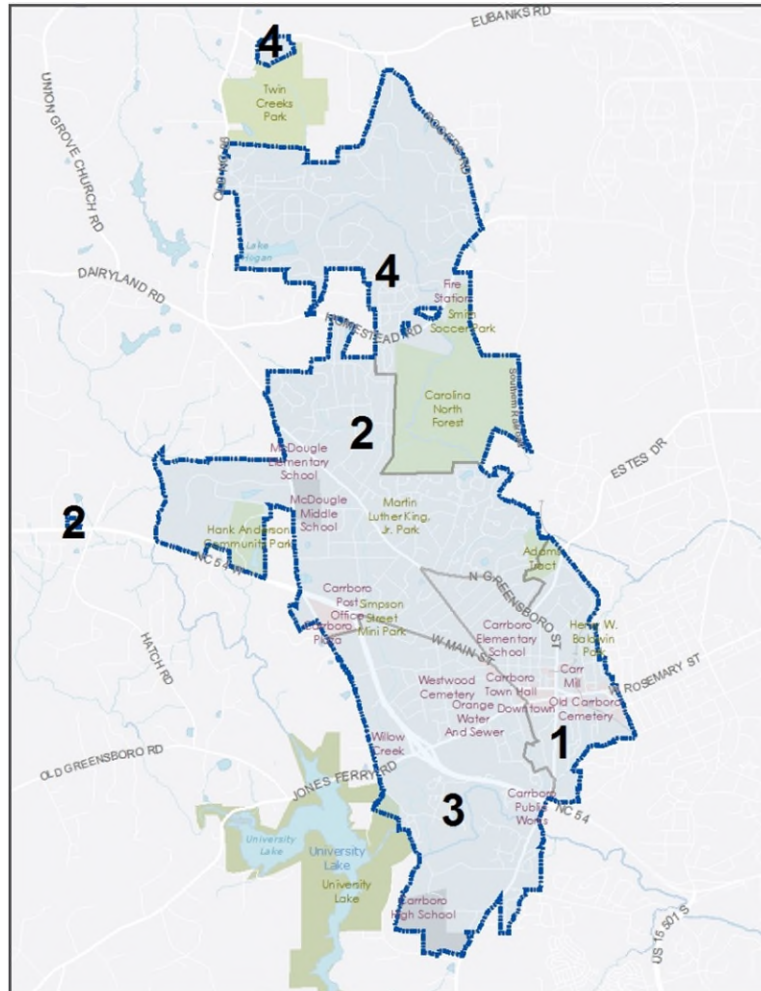

Monthly Events Narrative:

The month of October saw Carrboro record its first homicide since 2018. Two men were shot and one of the men died after an incident at 112 NC 54 on October 22nd. A suspect in the shooting was arrested and the case is still under investigation.

Officers served 4 Involuntary Commitments and transported 3 people for voluntary commitments. All 7 individuals were transported to UNC Hospital for assistance.

Calls for service increased this month over last by just over 100. The classification "Public Service" (person requesting a phone call from an officer) accounted for 9% (124 calls) of total officer time. "Disturbances" accounted for 5% (75 calls) and "Suspicious/Wanted" accounted for 4% (58 calls). "School Patrol" took 3% of officer's time this month and this category covers traffic direction at the various schools in Carrboro.
