The increase covers the Town's required salary-related expenses such as insurance, FICA, supplemental retirement, etc.

The Town charges businesses equipped with dumpsters for the collection and disposal of municipal solid waste, but does not have a fee structure for businesses that are serviced using roll-out containers. An analysis of fees in FY23 revealed approximately 45 businesses in Carrboro are currently serviced with roll-out containers.
