 Mayor Pro Tem Nowell, and Mayor Foushee were able to vote on last year's minutes.

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- 107 Council Member Haven O'Donnell expressed concern about airborne particulate
- 108 matter being released during the replacement of the Century Center's chiller
- 109 impacting community members walking by or dining in the area. She requested more
- 110 information about what is released externally during the process.

- shared that it would be best to vote on this item tonight, so the contract can move forward.
