Mayor and Board of Aldermen,

About a week ago, I sent you the enclosed e-mail from Frank Clifton which outlines solid waste and recycling issues in Orange County and how those issues might impact Carrboro and Chapel Hill.

George, Matt, and I met this morning and have scheduled recycling options for Board discussion on June 4. We would like to get direction from the Board before the summer break.

At this point, we think joining the solid waste tax district might be the best option for the Town. Mr. Clifton's e-mail also mentions a solid waste management authority, similar to the OWASA model. Orange County is also asking for the jurisdictions' consensus on moving forward with inter-local agreements.

In the interim, we also intend to move forward and participate in a study with Chapel Hill that includes a transfer station and local recycling options.
