

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE FOR THE
EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE MEASURES PROJECT IN THE MULTI-YEAR
GRANTS ADMINISTRATION FUND**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Carrboro that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the Grant Project Ordinance is hereby established and amended as follows:

SECTION I

This ordinance is to establish a budget for the Emergency Protective Measures project to be funded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the NC Emergency Management Agency. This project covers actions undertaken by the Town before, during, and immediately following the disaster to save lives, protect public health and safety, and prevent or reduce damage to improved property. Eligible activities include Emergency Operations Center activation, first responder force account labor, traffic and access control, evacuations, and other short-term emergency measures necessary to stabilize conditions and maintain essential service levels.

SECTION II

Revenue anticipated to be available to the Town to complete the project is as follows:
