As part of this work we approach all of our projects with an emphasis on "design thinking" -- that is, constantly prototyping and working to discover new pathways and approaches to our projects and problems. INFORMATION: The purpose of this agenda item is for the Board of Aldermen to consider three amendments to four provisions of Chapter 6 of the Town Code - Motor Vehicles and Traffic. Prepared in response to citizen inquiries, the amendments are designed to clarify different sections of the code for more consistency and, in the last example, to provide additional on-street parking to accommodate local resident and business needs.

All three amendments have been vetted by the Traffic and Parking Committee, the interdepartmental workgroup consisting of representatives from the Public Works, Police, Fire, Economic and Community Development and Planning departments. Public Works and Planning staff have conducted site visits to verify field measurements where appropriate. The draft amendments are described in more detail below.

Section 6-34(1)(g) - Bike Lanes on Hillsborough Road

The provisions relating to bike lanes along Hillsborough Road currently end at Lorraine Street. The proposed amendments would extend bike lanes along both sides of Hillsborough Road for the entire length of the road, from Main Street to Old Fayetteville Road (Attachment A).

Section 6-34(1)(j) & Section 6-19(b)(5) - Bike Lanes on Pathway Drive

Proposed Town Code amendments clarify that the provisions for bike lanes extend along both sides of Pathway Drive from Cates Farm Road to its eastern terminus, and prohibit on-street parking along the same segment of road from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday (Attachment B).

Parking along the south side of Cobb is further limited by three existing driveways that are heavily used. The proposed amendment removes the prohibition for parking along the south side of Cobb Street allowing for some parking toward the western end of the street (Attachment C).

FISCAL & STAFF IMPACT: Adopting the amendments would involve some cost and time for Public Works staff to install new signage related to parking restrictions and to restripe the bike lanes on Pathway Drive

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen consider the draft amendments provided in Attachments A through C.

Discuss Options for Shared Rosemary Parking Lot

PURPOSE: The purpose of this item is to discuss options for management and maintenance of the shared parking lot at Rosemary and Sunset.

DEPARTMENT: Economic and Community Development

CONTACT INFORMATION: Annette D. Lafferty, AICP Economic and Community Development Director

INFORMATION: The Town of Chapel Hill has requested that Town of Carrboro allow them to take over management and maintenance of a public parking lot that is currently owned jointly by Carrboro and Chapel Hill. The lot is located at the corner of Rosemary and Sunset; it is currently managed and maintained by Carrboro. Chapel Hill has acquired the right to lease a parcel immediately adjacent (east) to this lot and would like to expand and develop the new lot and redevelop the existing shared Rosemary lot, consistent with other parking lots that are metered in downtown Chapel Hill.

The new lot being created by Chapel Hill (see attachment 1) contains 23 spaces, 12 of which are being reserved as private parking and leased back to the owner of the lot, 7 spaces are being created for monthly permit only parking (\$95/mo) and 5 new, including 1 handicap, paid public parking spaces. Chapel plans to meter the 13 existing public spaces that are located on the Chapel Hill side of the Rosemary lot and have offered to meter the entire lot.

Town staff has identified four possible options for this lot.

- 1) Do nothing and leave the spaces as they are, unmarked.
- 2) Install signs on the Carrboro spaces stating that the spaces are reserved for Carrboro businesses and their customers only with no leases.
- 3) Install signs and lease the spaces to Carrboro businesses and their employees for \$350 annual fee for their private use.
- 4) Allow Chapel Hill to number and add the spaces to their parking management system, but keep them free and enforce time limits; 4a) or don't enforce time limits.
- 5) Allow Chapel Hill to number and add the spaces to their parking management system. This option would include charging fees of \$1.50 per hour with a 10 hour maximum time limit. Chapel Hill would be responsible



for enforcing time limits. Town of Chapel Hill Parking Services Parking Superintendent Brenda Jones estimated lot revenue to be \$11,600 and \$2,500 in citations. The cost for Chapel Hill to manage the lot is estimated to be \$6,750.

The final steps of the study include a citizen survey to determine interest and applicability of various pilot projects. Based on collected data it appears that the Town is a candidate for alternative collection schedules and methods of which it is the goal of Town staff to test with pilot projects in the near future. Kessler will deliver a final report detailing the collected data as well as providing guidance for implementing the proposed pilot projects.

FISCAL & STAFF IMPACT: Fiscal and staff impacts of varying degrees are associated with the design and implementation of current data collection and proposed solid waste pilot projects.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen receive the update.

PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND

This technical memorandum provides the results of the Residential Waste Composition Study (WCS) conducted by Kessler Consulting, Inc. (KCI) for the Town of Carrboro (Town). The objective of the WCS is to provide the Town with reliable information regarding the types and percentages of materials, including potentially recyclable materials, currently disposed of by its single-family residents. This information will assist the Town in developing future programs, including more focused and cost-effective resource management and recycling systems.

Fieldwork for the WCS was conducted concurrently with a similar study KCI was conducting for Orange County (County), thereby leveraging the resources already mobilized by KCI. Fieldwork took place at the City of Durham (City) Transfer Station during the week of October 24-28, 2016.

METHODOLOGY

KCI developed a methodology that was modelled after the County's previous waste composition studies in order to maintain continuity with the previous study results. KCI provided a Study Supervisor, Sorting Supervisor, additional labor to assist with sorting activities, all sorting equipment, and safety gear. The City provided the services of a loader and operator to pull samples at the direction of the Study Supervisor and remove waste upon completion of sorting activities.

During the week of October 24-28, 2016, KCI pulled a representative sample of at least 200 pounds from each of the Town's six weekly single-family residential routes (noted as automated side loader routes #1-#6). All samples were manually sorted into 40 material categories, which are defined in Attachment A. This list of material categories was developed taking into consideration the types of recyclables included in the Town's recycling program, as well as the County's previous studies.

Recyclables accepted by the Town include the following:

- o Cardboard
- o Newspaper
- Mixed paper
- Narrow-neck plastic containers
- o Plastic tubs #2, #4, and #5
- o Glass bottles and jars
- Aseptic and gable-top containers
- Aluminum cans and foil
- Steel cans and containers

Following the field work, data was analyzed as outlined in the ASTM Standard Test Method for Determination of the Composition of Unprocessed Municipal Solid Waste (D5231-92; reapproved 2008) to determine the percentage, by weight, of each material category. In addition to the weighted average, the 90 percent confidence interval was calculated for each material category. The confidence interval indicates that, with a 90 percent level of confidence, the actual arithmetic mean (the arithmetic mean obtained if an infinite number of samples were sorted) is within the upper and lower limits shown. This provides an understanding of how much variation occurred in the quantity of that material category in the samples sorted. Generally, the more homogeneous the waste stream and the greater the number of samples sorted, the higher the level of accuracy achieved and the narrower the margin between the upper and lower bounds of the confidence interval.

WCS RESULTS

Unless otherwise stated, all results presented in this section are expressed in percentage by weight. The percentages included in the tables and figures are the mean values for each material category.

The tables and figures provided at the end of this memorandum present the results of the Winter 2016 sorting event as listed below.

- Single-family residential waste results are provided in Figure 1 and Table 1. Table 1 summarizes the materials in the Town's single-family residential waste stream that offer the greatest potential for diversion through increased recycling or composting. Individual sample results provided in Attachment B.
- Table 2 provides a comparison of the Town's single-family residential waste stream to the countywide single-family residential results from the County's current and previous studies.

Comparisons with the previous studies demonstrate changes in the waste stream over time. For example, the percentage of newspapers and magazines has declined, reflecting the trend toward electronic news media and the commensurate downsizing of printed newspapers. It likely also reflects recycling efforts within the County. The percentage of glass containers has also declined, reflecting the trend toward replacing some types of glass with plastic packaging.

Results of the Town's residential waste composition revealed opportunities to increase waste diversion. Some of the key opportunities are as follows:

- Nearly 17 percent of the single-family residential waste stream consists of recyclables that are currently accepted in the Town's single stream recycling program (10.9% recyclable paper and 5.6% recyclable containers).
- Organic waste is the largest component of the single-family waste stream at over 53 percent of all materials disposed. Food waste makes up the largest component at 28.2 percent, followed by low-grade (compostable) paper at 15.3 percent.
- Just over 8 percent of the Town's single-family waste stream is comprised of materials that have the potential to be recycled or reused. These materials include textiles, other metals, electronic waste, and retail bags, all of which are accepted at the County's waste and recycling centers.

In all, nearly 78 percent of the Town's waste stream consists of recyclable or compostable materials. While it is unrealistic to believe that all of these materials can be diverted from disposal, results of this study demonstrate the existence of substantial opportunities for increased diversion through enhanced recycling and composting programs. Results of this study will assist the Town in benchmarking its

current waste diversion programs, as well as in designing and implementing future programs or program enhancements that target materials offering the greatest waste diversion opportunities.

KCI appreciates the opportunity to assist the Town with this project and to provide current and accurate composition data for use in future planning decisions. We look forward to assisting the Town with the remaining items of our scope to enhance the overall performance of its solid waste management system.

PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND

This technical memorandum provides the results of the Residential Waste Composition Study (WCS) conducted by Kessler Consulting, Inc. (KCI) for the Town of Carrboro (Town). The objective of the WCS is to provide the Town with reliable information regarding the types and percentages of materials, including potentially recyclable materials, currently disposed of by its single-family residents. This information will assist the Town in developing future programs, including more focused and cost-effective resource management and recycling systems.

Fieldwork for the WCS was conducted concurrently with a similar study KCI was conducting for Orange County (County), thereby leveraging the resources already mobilized by KCI. Fieldwork took place at the City of Durham (City) Transfer Station during the week of October 24-28, 2016.

METHODOLOGY

KCI developed a methodology that was modelled after the County's previous waste composition studies in order to maintain continuity with the previous study results. KCI provided a Study Supervisor, Sorting Supervisor, additional labor to assist with sorting activities, all sorting equipment, and safety gear. The City provided the services of a loader and operator to pull samples at the direction of the Study Supervisor and remove waste upon completion of sorting activities.

During the week of October 24-28, 2016, KCI pulled a representative sample of at least 200 pounds from each of the Town's six weekly single-family residential routes (noted as automated side loader routes #1-#6). All samples were manually sorted into 40 material categories, which are defined in Attachment A. This list of material categories was developed taking into consideration the types of recyclables included in the Town's recycling program, as well as the County's previous studies.

Recyclables accepted by the Town include the following:

- o Cardboard
- o Newspaper
- Mixed paper
- Narrow-neck plastic containers
- o Plastic tubs #2, #4, and #5
- o Glass bottles and jars
- Aseptic and gable-top containers
- Aluminum cans and foil
- Steel cans and containers

Following the field work, data was analyzed as outlined in the ASTM Standard Test Method for Determination of the Composition of Unprocessed Municipal Solid Waste (D5231-92; reapproved 2008) to determine the percentage, by weight, of each material category. In addition to the weighted average, the 90 percent confidence interval was calculated for each material category. The confidence interval indicates that, with a 90 percent level of confidence, the actual arithmetic mean (the arithmetic mean obtained if an infinite number of samples were sorted) is within the upper and lower limits shown. This provides an understanding of how much variation occurred in the quantity of that material category in the samples sorted. Generally, the more homogeneous the waste stream and the greater the number of samples sorted, the higher the level of accuracy achieved and the narrower the margin between the upper and lower bounds of the confidence interval.

WCS RESULTS

Unless otherwise stated, all results presented in this section are expressed in percentage by weight. The percentages included in the tables and figures are the mean values for each material category.

The tables and figures provided at the end of this memorandum present the results of the Winter 2016 sorting event as listed below.

- Single-family residential waste results are provided in Figure 1 and Table 1. Table 1 summarizes the materials in the Town's single-family residential waste stream that offer the greatest potential for diversion through increased recycling or composting. Individual sample results provided in Attachment B.
- Table 2 provides a comparison of the Town's single-family residential waste stream to the countywide single-family residential results from the County's current and previous studies.

Comparisons with the previous studies demonstrate changes in the waste stream over time. For example, the percentage of newspapers and magazines has declined, reflecting the trend toward electronic news media and the commensurate downsizing of printed newspapers. It likely also reflects recycling efforts within the County. The percentage of glass containers has also declined, reflecting the trend toward replacing some types of glass with plastic packaging.

Results of the Town's residential waste composition revealed opportunities to increase waste diversion. Some of the key opportunities are as follows:

- Nearly 17 percent of the single-family residential waste stream consists of recyclables that are currently accepted in the Town's single stream recycling program (10.9% recyclable paper and 5.6% recyclable containers).
- Organic waste is the largest component of the single-family waste stream at over 53 percent of all materials disposed. Food waste makes up the largest component at 28.2 percent, followed by low-grade (compostable) paper at 15.3 percent.
- Just over 8 percent of the Town's single-family waste stream is comprised of materials that have the potential to be recycled or reused. These materials include textiles, other metals, electronic waste, and retail bags, all of which are accepted at the County's waste and recycling centers.

In all, nearly 78 percent of the Town's waste stream consists of recyclable or compostable materials. While it is unrealistic to believe that all of these materials can be diverted from disposal, results of this study demonstrate the existence of substantial opportunities for increased diversion through enhanced recycling and composting programs. Results of this study will assist the Town in benchmarking its

current waste diversion programs, as well as in designing and implementing future programs or program enhancements that target materials offering the greatest waste diversion opportunities.

KCI appreciates the opportunity to assist the Town with this project and to provide current and accurate composition data for use in future planning decisions. We look forward to assisting the Town with the remaining items of our scope to enhance the overall performance of its solid waste management system.
