

REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION DEMAND MANAGEMENT GRANT PROJECT
ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation, Capital Area MPO, and Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro MPO have provided funding to the Triangle J Council of Governments to support, Triangle Choices, Transportation Demand Management activities in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro has partnered with the Town of Chapel Hill since 2010 on Transportation Demand Management program promotions; and

WHEREAS, Carrboro has developed a set of Transportation Demand Management activities as a subrecipient of the Town of Chapel Hill's FY23 Transportation Demand Management grant application; and

WHEREAS, Carrboro will receive up to \$7,500 or 50% reimbursement of expenses up to \$15,000 for Transportation Demand Management activities (such as Open Streets, a portion of the Transportation Planner's salary, and outreach materials).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Carrboro Town Council that:

The Council authorizes continued participation in regional Transportation Demand Management funding in FY23, with the Town of Chapel Hill.

The Transportation Demand Management funding shall be used for Open Streets, Bike Month a portion of the Transportation Planner's salary, and outreach materials.

Within five (5) days after this resolution is adopted, the Town Clerk shall file a copy of this resolution with the Town Manager and Finance Director.

This resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the Carrboro Town Council.
