AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF CARRBORO LAND USE ORDINANCE PROVISIONS RELATING TO ROAD AND SIDEWALK REQUIREMENTS *Draft 4-25-2018*

Section 1. Subparagraph (b) of the Town of Carrboro Land Use Ordinance Section 15-221, Road and Sidewalk Requirements in Unsubdivided Development, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Whenever (i) a lot is proposed to be developed residentially for more than four dwelling units or non-residentially in such a fashion as to generate more than 40 vehicle trips per day, and (ii) if the lot were to be subdivided, a street would be required running through the lot to provide a connection between existing or planned adjacent streets in accordance with the provisions of Sections 15-214 and 15-271(a), then the developer shall be required to construct and dedicate the same street that would have been required had the property been subdivided. On Town-owned properties, the Board of Aldermen may eliminate or reduce the requirements of this section for reservation and/or connection of right-of-way for vehicles so long as a reservation and/or connection for bicycles and pedestrians is provided.

- Section 2. All provisions of any Town Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.
- Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
