## A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CONSTRUCTION OF BIKE/PED IMPROVEMENTS AT THE MERRITT MILL-FRANKLIN –MAIN-BREWER INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, a project to improve the intersection of Brewer Lane-West Franklin Street-East Main Street-Merritt Mill Road Lane received State funding and is scheduled to be let for construction in October 2018; and

WHEREAS, staff of the Town of Carrboro, Town of Chapel Hill, and NCDOT have met on multiple occasions to develop conceptual design details which meet the needs of all parties; and,

WHEREAS, a conceptual design has since been completed and presented to staff of both towns, whom are both in agreement that said design represents a substantial improvement to the safety and comfort of cyclists and pedestrians traveling through this intersection; and

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost is \$350,000 and is to be funded and managed in its entirety by NCDOT and they have requested a resolution supporting the project be passed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has received information on the proposed design for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Carrboro Board of Aldermen supports construction of these improvements at the Merritt Mill-Franklin-Main-Brewer intersection and requests that the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proceed with the project in a timely fashion,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Carrboro Board of Aldermen provides the following additional comments on the project:
