113 114 115	WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro has been awarded funding from the Joint Economic Development Programs Article 46 Collaborative Outreach from Orange County to provide services or engage in economic development activities; and,

The Joint Economic Development Programs Article 46 Collaborative Outreach Grant in the amount of \$27,575.41 is hereby accepted and appropriated for economic development programs that aid in job creation, drive economic growth, support existing businesses, recruit new businesses, and assist in the promotion of other activities such as innovation and entrepreneurial growth, agri-tourism, and agriculture in Orange County.
