This agenda item is to ensure compliance with statutory requirements for the Firefighters' Relief Fund Board. **INFORMATION:** The Firefighters' Relief Fund (FRF) was established in 1907 to financially assist firefighters who are injured while performing their duties and to ensure that no firefighter would become financially destitute through no fault of their own. Currently, the FRF is governed by North Carolina G.S. 58-84 (<u>link <https://www.ncleg.net/enactedlegislation/statutes/html/byarticle/chapter\_58/article\_84.html></u>). Since the inception of the FRF, the fund has assisted firefighters who experience injury or loss of life while performing fire department duties.

The FRF is funded by a portion of the Gross Premium Tax (GPT) (G.S. 105-228.5(d)(3)) on insurance policies containing fire and lightning protection, as well as certain automotive policies. Of the total GPT collected, 20% is dedicated to the FRF. The fund is distributed by the Commissioner of Insurance to local firefighter relief funds annually. The Carrboro Fire-Rescue FRF receives approximately \$16,752 annually.

Funds from the FRF have been used to assist members diagnosed with cancer that was likely caused by their service, to offset the cost of annual firefighter physicals, and to assist members with significant physical injuries that caused them to be unable to work.

Fire departments must meet the following requirements to receive the tax collected within their fire district:

- Be a current member of the North Carolina State Firefighters' Association (NCSFA)
- Submit Firefighters' Relief Fund bank & financial statement(s) to the State Firefighters' Association by October 31 each year.

The FRF is managed by a local Board of Trustees. The makeup of the Board of Trustees is identified in Article 30 of G.S. 58-84 and shall consist of the following:

- Two (2) positions elected by the fire department;
- Two (2) positions appointed by City or County Commissioners;
- One (1) position appointed by the Insurance Commissioner.

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One of the five (5) board members will be elected as Treasurer.

Current fire department appointees were selected through an election process held by the Fire Department. Fire department appointees serve at the pleasure of the Fire Department.

The Commissioner of Insurance appointee is appointed by the Commissioner of Insurance and serves at the pleasure of the Commissioner.

To ensure compliance with FRF statutory requirements, the Town Council is requested to appoint Deputy Chief (Ret.) Forrest Wayne Lacock and Lieutenant (Ret.) Jefferson Ray Dunn to the Board of Trustees.

### Deputy Chief (Ret.) Forrest Wayne Lacock

Deputy Chief (Ret.) Forrest Wayne Lacock was appointed to the FRF Board of Trustees by the Board of Aldermen on 2 May 2017. The original appointment was for a two-year term; however, the general statute was amended by Session Law 2016-51 on June 23, 2016 to remove the length of terms and to include the language that "appointees serve at the pleasure of the governing body." Deputy Chief Lacock was last reappointed to a term with an expiration date of December 31, 2018 rather than no expiration per amended Session Law 2016-51.

Deputy Chief Lacock has been a resident of Carrboro for over 70 years. Deputy Chief Lacock served the country in the Army with an honorable discharge. After discharge he served the Town of Carrboro and the Fire-Rescue Department in various roles, eventually retiring as the Deputy Chief of Operations in 2002. He is an active member of Antioch Baptist Church and has served on several committees at Antioch Baptist Church and Damascus United Methodist Church. Deputy Chief Lacock is a founding member and board member of the South Orange Rescue Squad. Deputy Chief Lacock lives in the fire district and is qualified and eligible for this appointment.

### Lieutenant (Ret.) Jefferson Ray Dunn

Lieutenant (Ret.) Jefferson Ray Dunn is currently serving on the FRF Board of Trustees as a Fire Department Appointee. Based on the required makeup of the Board of Trustees an additional Town Council Appointment is needed. As such it is requested that Lieutenant Dunn be appointed to the Board of Trustees by the Town Council. Lieutenant Dunn has served on the Board of Trustees for over 10 years and is an excellent choice for appointment by the Town Council.

Lieutenant Dunn has lived in Carrboro for over 60 years. Lieutenant Dunn joined the Carrboro Fire-rescue Department in 1990 and served the department in various roles for over 30 years. He served as a Fire Driver, Mechanic, and Lieutenant, and served as Acting Captain on many occasions. Lieutenant Dunn has been and continues to be a fire service instructor and a mentor to many current and past members of the department. Lieutenant Dunn is still active in the fire service as a volunteer with the White Cross Fire Department. Lieutenant Dunn lives in the fire district and is qualified and eligible for this appointment.

FISCAL IMPACT: There are no fiscal or staff impacts associated with this agenda item.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Town Council approve the resolution to appoint Forrest W. Lacock and Jefferson R. Dunn to the Firefighters' Relief Fund Board of the Carrboro Fire-Rescue Department.

Advisory Board appointments follows the Town's Advisory Board Recruitment and Appointment Policy originally adopted by Council on 11-21-2017 and most recently revised on 3-16-2021.

**INFORMATION:** The Board of Adjustment shall consist of 9 members. Seven members, appointed by the Town Council, shall reside within the town. One member, appointed by the Orange County Board of Commissioners, shall reside within the Town's Extraterritorial planning area. One member, appointed by the Orange County Board of Commissioners, shall reside within the Town's Extraterritorial planning area.

The Board of Adjustment currently has three (3) vacancies for in-town seats and one county-appointee seat up for re-appointment recommendation.

Due to a recent resignation by in-town Board of Adjustment member, Marcus Page, the Clerk's office has been notified by the staff liaison that the Board of Adjustment runs the risk of not having a quorum at meetings.

A new application was received by Jenifer Wolfe for an in-town seat on the board. Ms. Wolfe has attended a meeting and Brian Hageman, Chair of the Board of Adjustment, has submitted the chair form.

Additionally, John Baker, who currently serves as an Orange County appointee, is up for re-appointment and is interested in continuing to serve. Mr. Baker was initially appointed to fill an unexpired partial term and has served one-full three-year term. The Council usually recommends a person to serve as the Orange County seat designee, which is appointed by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners. The Clerk's office corresponded with Orange County's Clerks office on February 27, 2023, who stated they had advertised the position, but had not received any additional applicants for this seat. The town has also not received any new applications for this seat.

## FISCAL IMPACT: N/A

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that Council review and consider making an appointment to the Board of Adjustment's in-town seat to alleviate potential quorum issues. **INFORMATION:** The Northern Transition Area Advisory Committee consists of 5 members; 3 appointed by the Town of Carrboro and Orange County Board of Commissioners, and 2 appointed by the Town Council. All members shall be residents of the unannexed portions of the Northern Study Area.

The Northern Transition Area Advisory Committee (NTAAC) currently has two seats available for appointment. Two expiring seats that are eligible for reappointment are currently filled by Meg McGurk and Edward Witkin, who have both indicated they would like to be reappointed to the NTAAC. It should be noted that Meg McGurk was first appointed in 2018 to fill an unexpired term through 2020. In 2020, she was then reappointed for a first full-term (three years). She would still be eligible for to serve because this pending reappointment would be her second full-term (three years).

Edward Witkin currently serves as one of the Orange County representative seats of the NTAAC. Mr. Witkin was first recommended to be appointed by Carrboro Town Council, and subsequently appointed, by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) in 2020 for a first full-term (three years). He was contacted by the county clerk's office on his interest in reappointment to another term and confirmed interest to both the county and town clerks on February 6, 2023. If recommended for reappointment to the Orange County BOCC, this would be his second full-term (three years). There are currently no other pending applicants for the NTAAC.

Information on these two members is included as Attachment B.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this agenda item is request that the Town Council accept the Police and Mental Health Collaborations for Diversion Programs Grant to provide a social worker in the Carrboro Police Department.

The Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department submitted this grant to funds efforts to divert those community members facing mental health and/or substance use disorder issues from the criminal justice system and connect them with support services. Demographics and income levels of individuals facing mental health and substance use issues tend to be disparate from the demographics and income levels of the greater community. Please see attached Racial Equity pocket questions for additional information.

**INFORMATION:** The Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department applied for a N.C. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) grant in the Summer of 2022 to provide funds for a mental health diversion social worker position in each Orange County law enforcement agency. This position would work to divert people experiencing mental health or substance use issues from the criminal justice system and towards supportive care. The grant was awarded to the County in the Fall of 2022. The Carrboro Police Department wrote a letter of support for the grant and is slated to receive funding for a social worker position along with the other law enforcement agencies in the county - Chapel Hill Police Department, Hillsborough Police Department, and the Orange County Sheriff's Office - all of which have accepted, or are expected to accept, the grant.

In 2022, the Carrboro Police Department responded to over 200 calls for individuals experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis. It is expected that these numbers will increase over time as individuals in mental health crisis and substance use rates increased for years prior to the COVID-19 pandemic and have continued that trend. Embedding social workers within law enforcement agencies has become a national model designed to assist in diverting people from the criminal justice system and connecting vulnerable populations to support services. This grant enhances the Carrboro Police Department's ability beyond the current Crisis Intervention Training (CIT), de-escalation, and other mental health training for officers and would give the department capacity and resources to directly connect individuals in crisis to supportive care and avoid potential criminal justice involvement.

The Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department will receive a total of \$1,193,750 for a period starting from February 2023 through September 30, 2025. The Town of Carrboro's total portion is \$152,518 to cover salary, benefits, equipment, and supplies for a social worker for two years. The funding source for this program is through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding via the Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG). The Town will enter into a subcontract with the Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department. The grant does not require the Town to commit to funding this position at the end of the grant term.

Separate from this grant, ARPA funds have been allocated for a mental health position within the police department. Initial data collection from the first few months from this grant will determine if this requested ARPA-funded position is needed to support or expand this diversion effort. Considerations will include - case load, potential expanded social worker hours, and on-call and emergency call back options.

The Community Safety Task Force will receive an update on the grant at the March 6, 2023 meeting.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Grant acceptance will have staff and fiscal impact commensurate with hiring and supervising an employee and providing a vehicle for transportation needs. No other significant costs are anticipated.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Town Manager recommends that the Town Council adopt the Project Ordinance to accept the grant.

WHEREAS, the Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department has been awarded a contract through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) via the Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG) to deliver services for "*Police and Mental Health Collaborations for Diversion Programs;* and,

WHEREAS, the total amount of this award is \$1,193,750 beginning February 1, 2023 through September 1, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, this award will support a comprehensive approach involving the Orange County Sheriff's Office, and the Police Departments of Chapel Hill, Carrboro and Hillsborough; and,

WHEREAS, funding will be provided for a social worker position to be hired in each of the law enforcement agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the Town is required to enter a subcontract with the Criminal Justice Resource Department; and,

WHEREAS, funding will be provided to Freedom House to hire a Clinician and PSS; and,

WHEREAS, a Mental Health Diversion Coordinator in the Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department will coordinate the team's work and ensure grant data and reporting is completed; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council deems this to be a worthy project to divert individuals with mental health and other social issues from the criminal justice system.

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO THAT:

- 1. Funding for the *Police and Mental Health Collaborations for Diversion Programs* shall be accounted for in the Special Revenue Fund.
- 2. Total revenues in the amount of \$152,518.13 are anticipated to be available to the Town by subcontract with the Orange County Criminal Justice Resource Department
- 3. The following amount is appropriated for expenditure in the following manner:

### Racial Equity Pocket Questions

### What are the racial impacts?

The social worker position funded in this grant is primarily tasked with diverting individuals from the criminal justice system to more appropriate mental health service options. People experiencing mental health and substance use concerns tend to be the most vulnerable in our community and racial and income data of this population is consistently disparate from the overall community demographics. Mental health care data suggests that there are differences among racial, ethnic, and income groups' ability to access and continue mental health care. The recent COVID-19 pandemic has shown that negative impacts are disparate for certain sub-groups in the greater population. This grant focuses on reaching the most vulnerable in our population and connecting them to resources to improve wellbeing.

### Who is or will experience burden?

Mental health and social service providers will have additional clients in need of services and support. This grant provides for additional mental health positions to support an anticipated increase in client numbers and need for sustained care over time to meet an existing community need. Metrics collected will guide future resource needs and program changes.

### Who is or will experience benefit?

Members of the community with mental health or substance use disorders will be better connected to appropriate services and supported in their efforts. This benefit extends to family and community members who may be less affected by individuals experiencing these difficulties when behavior manifests in disruptive ways. The police department will be enabled to corespond with an officer and a social worker in order to more fully determine best options in situations involving mental health and substance use issues. This ability to provide more appropriate services has been shown to reduce criminal actions in the future by the affected people.

### What are the root causes of inequity?

Mental health services are under resourced and not robust enough to provide consistent and supportive care to individuals with mental health conditions and/or substance use disorders. This lack of system capacity has resulted in inappropriate criminal justice system involvement for people suffering from these issues.

Some people fear the stigma of seeking help for mental health or substance use concerns due to community beliefs. People can also have concerns due to mistrust of the mental health or medical field because of historical disparities in treatment and outcomes.

In addition, many people lack the financial resources necessary to afford mental health and substance use treatment and care. Coupled with limited options for health insurance and limited coverage of treatment options for some people with health insurance, accessing and continuing care for these issues can be extremely difficult.

### What might be the unintended consequences of this action or strategy?

While this model of diversion and service provision is being used nationally and shows success in reducing criminal justice involvement and reducing crime related to these issues, this model is mostly new to this area outside of Chapel Hill Police Department's Crisis Unit work. We anticipate that success will be mirrored here, but the data gathered will tell the story of program impacts. For this reason, multiple metrics will be tracked to determine if this effort is effective in reducing criminal justice involvement and overall negative effects from a personal and community perspective.

There is a possibility that certain people will not take advantage of the mental health and substance abuse resources in this program due to concerns about potential stigma related to seeking assistance and appearing weak to others. These concerns are not limited to this model program and reflect a larger issue with stigma and mental health/substance abuse treatment. Efforts continue to combat this concern and the social worker in the police department could make strides through training and education of community members to reduce this concern.

**INFORMATION:** This agenda item will allow the Town Council to consider making appointments to the Climate Action Team.

**Section 3-24.16 Climate Action Team (a)** There shall be a Climate Action Team (CAT) consisting of nine members appointed by the Town Council. Members shall be residents, business owners, or employees in the Town or extraterritorial planning jurisdiction or the Town's joint planning transition area. All such members shall be interested in or have expertise relevant to the duties of the CAT. At least one member should have experience related to community organizing or environmental justice. One seat should be reserved for a Carrboro resident currently enrolled in public, private, or home school at the high school level.

Original appointments to the Climate Action Team were made by Council on October 12, 2021, and October 19, 2021. These members were appointed for three-year staggered terms. There currently are two vacancies on the Climate Action team due to resignations. Both seats have an initial term expiration date of 2/2025.

Applications have been received from: Greg Randolph, Jane Danielwicz, Riz Rashdi, Nicholas Stover and Meg Molloy. Chair Forms have also been submitted for these applicants.

A resolution making appointments is included as Attachment A. Applications and Chair Forms are included as Attachment B, and an information matrix is included as Attachment C.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal or staff impact related to this item.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Town staff recommends that Town Council discuss and consider making appointments to the Climate Action Team vacant seats if the Council so desires. The Council can also appoint these individuals to serve a term through 2/2025, which is the initial expiration of the inaugural terms, but it is recommended to extend these terms to be a three-year appointment which would expire 2/2026 to prevent multiple expirations in 2/2025.

The core of my public health professional work has been action-oriented, evidence-based, community change campaigns that engage large numbers of organizations and individuals to establish healthy environments where healthy options are the default option. My experience is that taking the time to listen helps to build partnerships and to align interests, making the process accessible, providing options for what someone values most, making the process fairly simple, visible and fun can build critical mass and high engagement in a few years. Many of the projects have been public policy or private organizational or neighborhood policy, ie tobacco-free hospital and workplace campaign; access to healthy affordable foods at schools and workplaces; built environment to promote safe and accessible bike ped areas in neighborhoods -one involved working with the Northside Neighborhood with the Go Chapel Hill project with Town of Chapel Hill. Another was the 'Power of 10' campaign working with the 10 largest employers in all 100 counties to establish a multi-layer healthy work environment. Change campaigns work well when there is visible friendly competition within peer groups, they can share how they are making things work, and they see that they are part of something bigger. Starting with 2 or 3 schools, businesses or neighborhoods can lead to the next 2 or 3 groups joining through waves of engagement. Mapping progress is very helpful because people want to see where good things are happening and human nature tends to want to fill in the gaps (and bring positivity to their own community or workplace or school or neighborhood). I am currently working with Care4Carolina to create conditions where the NC General Assembly passes Medicaid Expansion - my role is business and community leader engagement - working across the state having discussions to secure endorsements and OpEds and visible leadership from county commissions; town councils; chambers of commerce; business leaders; elected leaders; faith leaders; and organizations who wish to join the coalition, I've seen a sea change in local and state discussions and support for closing the health insurance coverage gap in the past couple of years - conservative leaders who fought it for years are now saying it is the right time. We can build strong support for climate change in Carrboro and even those who may oppose it now will be part of collective action in several years.

#### Reasons You Wish to be Appointed\*

I am interested in addressing climate change in my local community. I am interested in the Green Neighborhood concept and think that my experience can help shape, support and extend this type of campaign across Carrboro. I think Green Schools, Green Businesses, Green Government, Green Neighborhoods and other categories could build towards a 'Carrboro - 2 Degrees Cooler' campaign which both defines the climate change goal of 2 degrees, and also fits with Carrboro's cool place to live vibe. I believe that in 4-5 years we could engage 75% or more of the community in making impactful changes that we can measure and report alongside broader outcome measures.

Economic, educational, environmental, justice, and health concerns are heightened among historically marginalized community members and in structurally excluded people and neighborhoods. Mitigating climate change will require multiple and sustained practice changes from all corners of our community, which will require comprehensive and broad participation with leadership from traditional and nontraditional leaders from all racial and social groups that make up Carrboro. These issues are intertwined and we will only be successful when we are intentional about equitable, diverse and inclusive processes and community engagement.
