INFORMATION: Mr. Phil Szostak has submitted an application to subdivide a 6.79 acre lot at 721 Jones Ferry Road to create a second lot. The property is located at the southwest corner of the Jones Ferry Road and Old Fayetteville Road / Berryhill Drive intersection (see yellow lot on Attachment A - Vicinity Map), and is zoned Watershed Residential. If approved, the CUP would allow for the creation of one additional lot, for a total of two lots. One lot is proposed to be 4.79 acres and the other lot 2 acres. Town Council is asked to open the public hearing and continue it to the Tuesday, March 9 Council meeting. Additional details about the application will be included in the March 9 Agenda Item.

FISCAL & STAFF IMPACT: Permitting and application fees paid by applicant. No additional fiscal

impacts noted at this time.

RECOMMENDATION: Town staff recommends that Council open the public hearing and continue it to the Tuesday, March 9 Council meeting.
