INFORMATION: The Town Manager’s recommended budget includes an allocation of \$220,000 to be distributed to local nonprofit agencies providing services to the citizens of Carrboro. Over a period of several months, the applications for funding were reviewed by the Human Services Advisory Commission. There were a total of 52 applications received, and requests for funding exceeded \$324,000. The Human Services Advisory Commission’s recommended funding for the applicants is included with this item as Attachment B.

FISCAL & STAFF IMPACT: The staff impact of this item is related to the processing and distribution of grants to non-profit agencies. The fiscal impact is the \$220,000 included in the FY 2015-2016 budget for the purpose of supporting local nonprofit agencies.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Board of Aldermen consider approving the recommendations of the Human Services Advisory Commission by approving the resolution in Attachment A.
