pursuing the consolidation of some of the town's advisory boards and commissions to address efficiencies. On February 13, 2024 staff presented recommendations at the Council work session. Council directed staff to meet with commissions and boards that were being considered. TPTF and REC have a similar purpose. See Attachment A for meeting summary.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** No fiscal impact. The consolidation is budget neutral. All funding should remain to offset projects and commission needs.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends consolidating the Truth Plaque Task Force and Racial Equity Commission. The newly formed commission will meet and develop a charge and membership structure to bring back for Council consideration in the fall.
