**INFORMATION:** The Orange County Partnership to End Homelessness was created in 2008 to coordinate activities and funding to end homelessness in Orange County. OCPEH is jointly funded by Orange County (39%) and the Towns of Carrboro (15%), Chapel Hill (41%), and Hillsborough (5%).
