Request to Set a Public Hearing on Renewal of an Annexation Boundary Agreement for the Towns of Carrboro and Chapel Hill

In 1995, the Town entered into an agreement to clarify the annexation limits of both Towns, to minimize splitting properties between the Towns and complicating land use permit approvals, and to codify principles of protection for the entranceways to the Towns along Smith Level Road. Racial Equity Pocket questions will be completed for the public hearing in April.
